**Question:**

Senator Evans asked in writing: Is it possible for an Indigenous Employment Centre and Job Network to both claim an outcome for one person who obtains a job placement that they both have worked with? Is it therefore possible under your system, that one job placement may be recorded as two outcomes?

**Answer:**

Yes. Where a job seeker is assisted by both an Indigenous Employment Centre and Job Network, both may claim an outcome where the job seeker's employment meets the contract requirements.
