**Question:**

Senator Wong asked in writing: Vocational Rehabilitation Services. What would happen if demand outstripped supply?

**Answer:**

There are two streams for VRS:

- Demand Driven; and
- Fixed Place.

The Demand Driven services are available to all eligible jobseekers with partial work capacity and part-time participation requirements. Job seekers with full-time participation requirements would be referred to Job Network.

If demand for Fixed Places outstrips supply, other eligible job seekers would be placed on a waitlist.
