Senator Colbeck asked the following questions provided in writing.

Question

\$1million for ForestWorks Establishment as an ISC

A \$1 million fund was allocated to ForestWorks in order to implement and operate the new Forest Industries Skills Council. Can a full detailed breakdown of the spending of this fund be provided? Over which financial years was the \$1 million spent?

Answer

On 22 February 2008 the Hon Tony Burke MP, Minister for Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry wrote to the Deputy Prime Minister the Hon Julia Gillard MP that \$1 million would be transferred to DEEWR to towards the establishment of ForestWorks as an Industry Skills Council.

This money formed part of the initial funding for the establishment and first two years operation of ForestWorks ISC. ForestWorks became an ISC on 18 April 2008. The table below shows the (GST exclusive) funding provided to the ISC in the 2007-08 and 2008-09 financial years.
