Senator CASH—In Victoria, since the state government announced increased audits and a list of providers who are at risk, how many providers have been suspended or their accreditation cancelled?

Answer

The Victorian Registration and Qualifications Authority provides a public listing of providers whose registration as registered training organisations (RTO) have been cancelled or suspended at the following website: <u>http://www.vrqa.vic.gov.au/vet/cancel.htm</u>

Since 20 May 2009, when the Victorian Minister for Skills and Workforce Participation, the Hon Jacinta Allan MP announced an immediate and rapid audit into the operations of Victoria's international education providers, the Commonwealth is aware the registrations of four providers have been cancelled and the registration of one provider has been suspended in relation to audit activity conducted by the Victorian authority.
