Question

The following questions relate to the Interview component of the Formal Skills Assessment:

- a) How is the interview conducted and;
- b) how long does it take?
- c) How is this component assessed?
- d) Does it involve any practical assessment of the applicant's skills?
- e) Are there any international branches for offshore applications to be interviewed?
- f) If no, how is this carried out?

Answer

- a) The technical interview is conducted by an Australian qualified workplace assessor.
- b) DEEWR service standards require that the full assessment process be completed within 7 weeks of commencement. Within this timeframe the RTO has discretion over the timing of each element of the process.
- c) The technical interview is used to gather evidence against the competencies of the relevant qualification.
- d) The service delivery and assessment arrangements provide for RTOs to undertake practical assessments where this is deemed necessary.
- e) Yes.
- f) In the case where and RTO does not maintain a permanent presence offshore alternative arrangements include but are not limited to:
 - Fly in, Fly out services
 - Remote, technology based services (video conference, web based solutions etc)
 - Onshore services
