## Question

## **JOB SEEKERS**

Providers have indicated that there is a tendency for job seekers to be 'parked'. What is the Department doing to ensure that job seekers are being serviced?

## Answer

Notwithstanding Suspended status, job seekers are able to volunteer to participate in employment services and receive a full range of Stream Services.

Around 76 per cent of all Suspensionsare due to one of the following factors:

- Job seekers undertaking part-time work (18 per cent of all Suspensions);
- Provisional Exits(comprising 15 per cent of all Suspensions).
  Provisional Exits apply to an eligible job seekerplaced in either employment oreducation which is likely to result in a Full Outcome. In addition, voluntary work accounts for 9 per cent of all Suspensions;
- Temporary reduced work capacity(as determined by Job Capacity Assessment providers on appropriate evidence) comprising 20 per cent of all Suspensions; and
- Temporary medical incapacity (comprising 14 per cent of all Suspensions) as determined by Centrelink on appropriate evidence.
