CHAPLAINCY PROGRAM

Senator MASON—It will tender further advice as to how it should be run and so forth, the shape of it. How much did the process cost? Do we know that? Ms Wall—The consultation process? Senator MASON—Yes, the consultation process. Do we know that? Ms Wall—I do not think I have that with me. Senator MASON—Could you take that on notice? Ms Wall—Certainly. Senator MASON—When this is finished and the minister has seen the discussion paper could this parliamentary committee have a copy of it? Is that possible, Ms Wall. Ms Wall—We will take it on notice.

Answer

As at 1 November 2010, \$355,000 had been spent on the consultation process.
