Mapping of funding and regulatory arrangements for higher education

"I refer to the June 2011 report by the Melbourne Graduate School of Education (which report was commissioned by the Ministerial Council for Education, Early Childhood Development and Youth Affairs -MCEECDYA) mapping the funding and regulatory arrangements across the Commonwealth and State and Territories in relation to school funding.

a. Has any consideration been given to a similar report in relation to mapping the funding and regulatory arrangements in relation to higher education?"

Answer

From 30 January 2012, the Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency (TEQSA) will be responsible for the regulation and accreditation of all Australian higher education providers.

The Department is considering a mapping exercise of the responsibilities of higher education regulation.
