**National Disability Recruitment Coordinator**

Senator FIFIELD: How many people have been placed as a result of the program overall? Ms Buffinton: There has been two separate contracts. There was a national disability recruitment coordinator that existed before 1 March 2010 under a previous contract. The contract was relet and a new provider came in. I would have to take on notice the breakdown for 2009-10 because the figures would go up to 28 February. I have a figure for the whole year of 430 but there would be a split. So I would need to take that on notice.

**Answer**

The National Disability Recruitment Coordinator program commenced in 2004 and has placed 4495 Disability Employment Services participants into employment from 1 July 2004 to 30 June 2011.
