Answer

On 23 March 2012, the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR)—in consultation with the then Skills Australia Secretariat—responded to a request from the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) for advice on its proposed principles and methodology to inform its work on the composition of the Consolidated Sponsored Occupations List (CSOL).

DIAC did not seek advice from DEEWR on the labour market status of occupations being considered for inclusion on the CSOL (such as flight attendant).
