## Long Day Care

Senator NASH: Thanks. Have you been advised of many changes of ownership? Obviously that happens as a process. When there is a change ownership, are you advised of that? Have there been many of those in the last 12 months? Ms Taylor: I will take that on notice. I do not have that with me. Senator NASH: Have many centres closed in the last 12 months? Ms Taylor: Again, I will take that on notice. Senator NASH: And out of any that have closed in the last 12 months, how many of those were community based? Ms Taylor: Yes, certainly.

#### Answer

#### Services that have changed ownership or closed.

In the 12 months from October 2011 to September 2012 there were 773 services that advised the Department they were closing or changing ownership and 1716 services that opened. Details are in **Table A** below.

#### Community Based Services that have closed.

The data collected on services does not identify whether they are 'community based' organisations. Rather the data classifies services as 'Not for Profit' or 'For Profit'. Details of changes of ownership and closures from October 2011 to September 2012 broken down by 'Not for Profit' or 'For Profit' is provided in **Table A** below.
