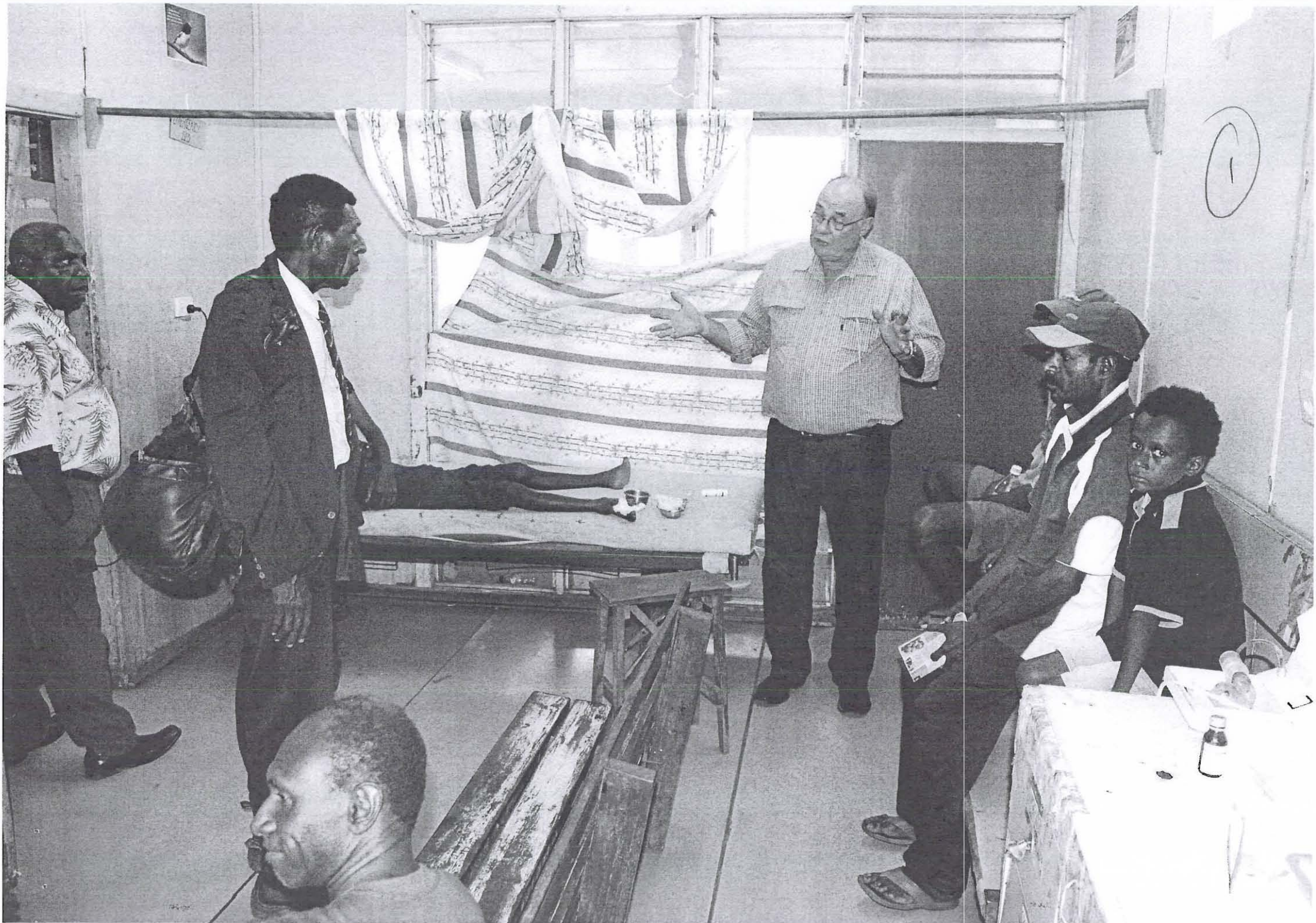

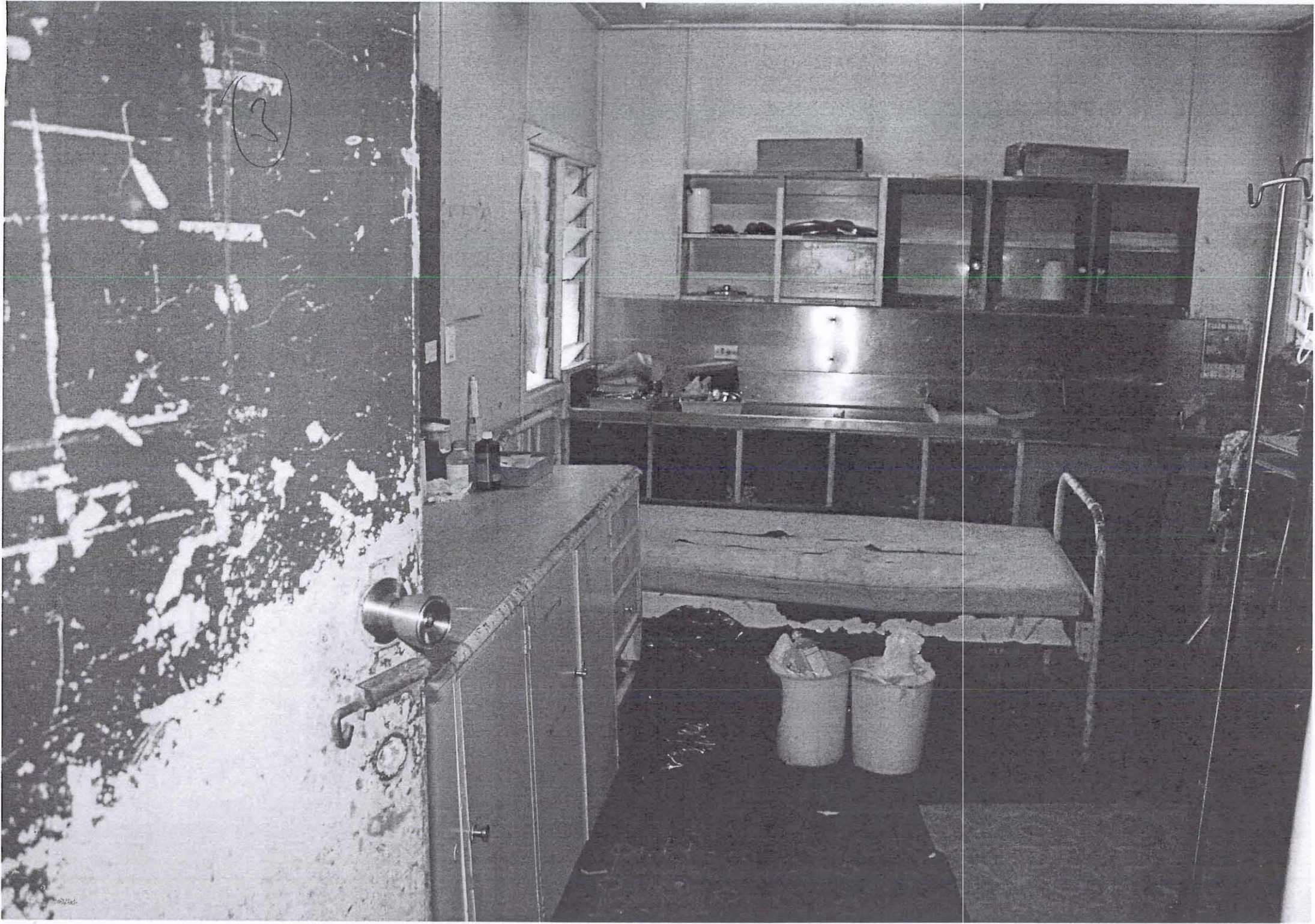

- 1 Patients waiting to be seen in the emergency room – note patient with a cut foot waiting on the sole ‘Emergency Bed’
- 2 Whole families camp around beds in the general ward
- 3 The drug room, with no drugs or refrigeration
- 4 Peeling paint on the ceiling in the children’s ward, note lack of mattresses on beds
- 5 Bathroom amenities in single quarters, note tub of water for washing, shower facilities are to the right
- 6 Open sewers directly outside access to staff quarters, stench was disgusting
- 7 Kitchen in staff quarters, note hole in the floor to the right – opens up on to open sewers
- 8 Recreation room for staff
- 9 Entrance to the staff quarters, note missing windows, broken panelling
- 10 Temporary isolation ward – upgraded with a coat of paint, new linoleum flooring and bedding (but no fans or air-con) which cost AusAID more than \$40,000





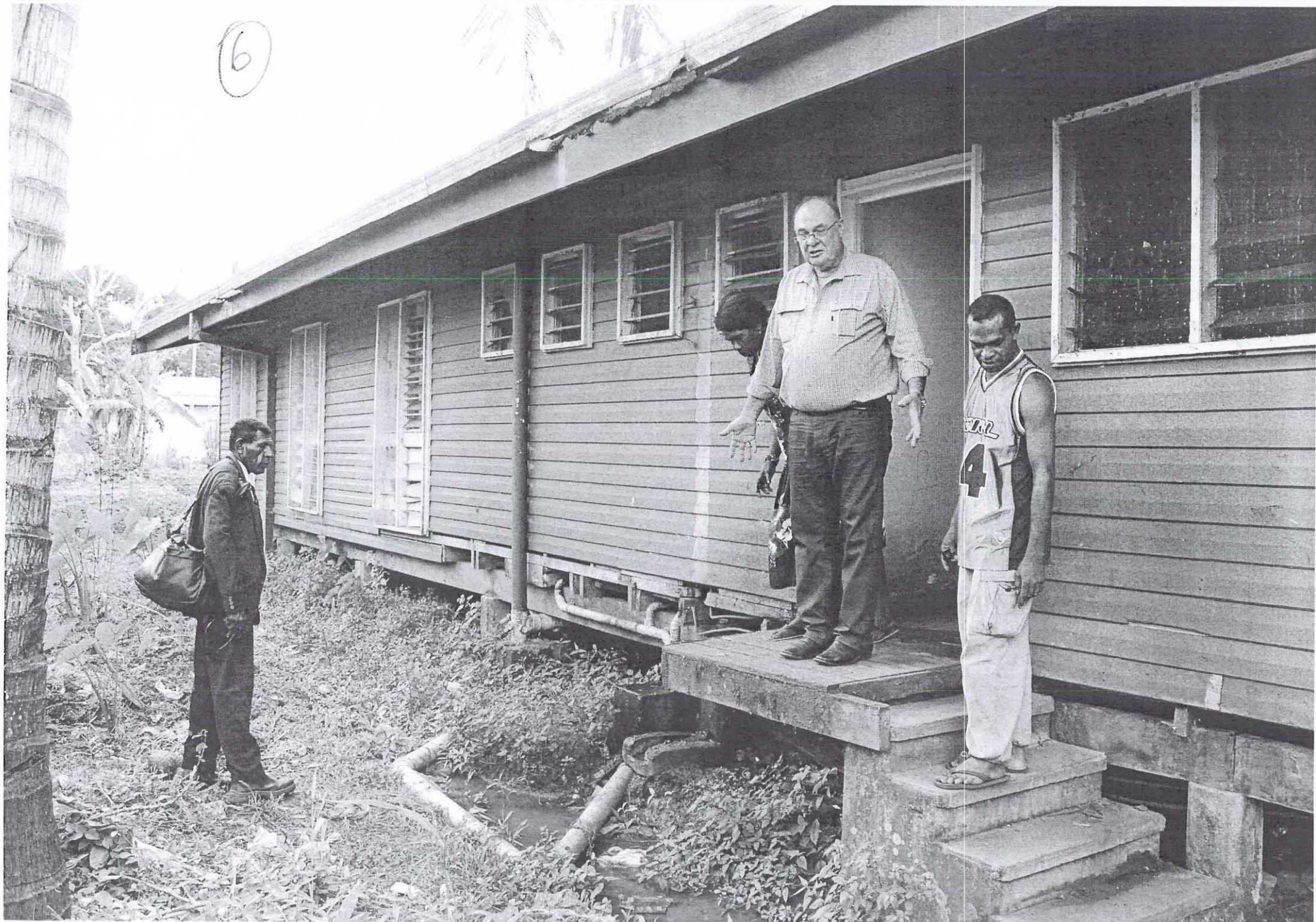


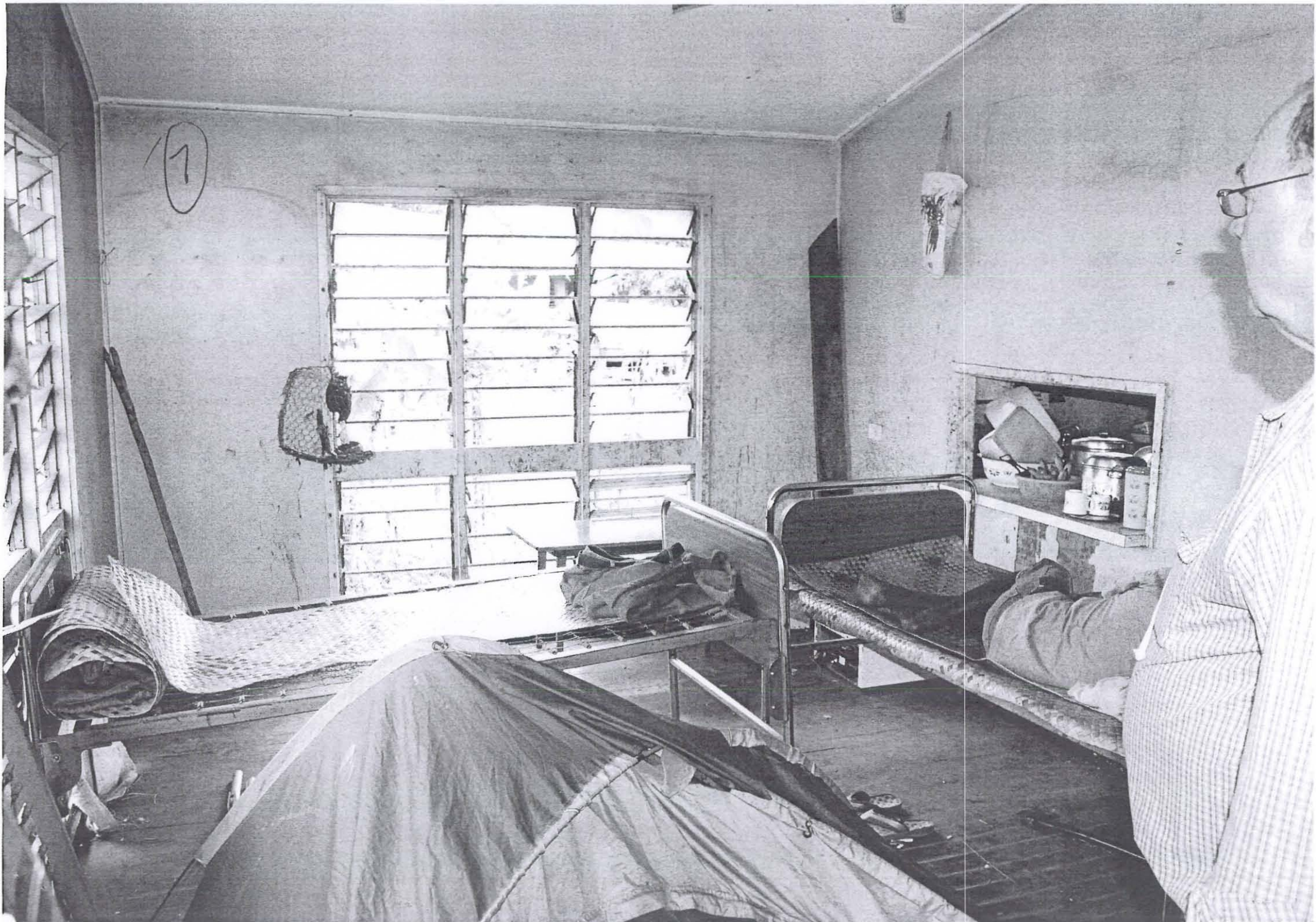
