



MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT (LIFE GOLD PASS) ACT 2002 DOCUMENTATION TO CONFIRM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The *Members of Parliament (Life Gold Pass) Act 2002* (the Act) provides that the spouse of a Life Gold Pass holder is entitled to travel at Commonwealth expense to accompany or join the pass holder on 25 or 40 return trips per annum. The Act defines 'spouse' as a "person's legally married husband or legally married wife".
