Senator Evans asked: What are current numbers of Departmental Liaison Officers in each Minister's Office, and what is the reason for any changes in those numbers since the last round of Estimates?

Answer: At the last estimates hearing in May 2004 there were 72 Departmental Liaison Officers (DLOs). There are now 67 DLOs. The variation reflects the portfolio changes made to the Ministry following the 2004 election and announced by the Prime Minister on 22 October 2004.

The attached table shows the number of DLOs allocated to each Minister's office. The DLO allocated to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Prime Minister is also the DLO to the Minister Assisting the Prime Minister.
