# SENATOR EVANS asked on 14/2/2006:

- 1. According to current plans and projections, by what year will the Smartcard program be a) fully operational and b) properly utilised by doctors and patients?
- 2. Please provide the content of the plan to conduct a study into privacy issues related to the development and introduction of the Smartcard program?
- 3. Will the study into privacy issues related to the development and introduction of the Smartcard program be part conducted by community, academic and NGO stakeholders?

## **Answer:**

- 1. Until such time as the government agrees to introduce a smart card, plans and projections regarding when a card could be fully operational and utilised are not available.
- 2. The Smart technologies and services task force has undertaken the development of an initial Privacy Impact Assessment with input from external agencies and the Privacy Commissioner, to accompany a business case regarding the introduction of smart card technology for accessing health and social services.
- 3. The initial Privacy Impact Assessment was prepared by Clayton Utz, with advice from Mr Nigel Waters a former Deputy Federal Privacy Commissioner. Both Clayton Utz and Mr Waters are experienced in this field.

This answer required 1 hour at a cost of \$50 to prepare.
