Answer:

Ad hoc approvals for slightly larger offices based on staffing size, and other requirements, of Parliamentary Secretaries, have been given since 16 August 2005.

However, additional office space for Parliamentary Secretaries, as a standard entitlement, was agreed to by the Prime Minister on 23 June 2006.
