**Senator Faulkner asked:**

**Senator FAULKNER**—There was some competition associated with the Rock Enrol website, conducted by the AEC, wasn't there?

**Mr Pickering**—Yes, there was.

**Senator FAULKNER**—How many entries did that get?

**Mr Pickering**—I will take that on notice. I am not sure of the answer.

**Answer:**

There were two competitions associated with the Rock Enrol website.

The first on-line competition ran from 17 December 2006 to 31 December 2006. To be eligible to enter the competition entrants had to be 17 years of age or older and correctly enrolled. The prizes for this competition consisted of double passes to the Big Day Out concerts. It received a total of 3134 on-line entries during this period.

The second on-line competition began on 2 March 2007 and will run until 20 April 2007. The same eligibility criteria apply. The prize for this competition is 10 T-shirts signed by artists participating in the Big Day Out concerts. The total number of entries for this competition will not be known until after 20 April 2007.
