SENATOR MOORE asked on 16/02/2007:

Carer's Payment / Allowance – eligibility for \$600 'top-up' at the end of the financial year:

- 1. How do people qualify?
- 2. How long do they have to be in receipt of a Centrelink payment?
- 3. Would a person in receipt of payment from July through to April receive a top-up payment? Even a pro-rata payment?
- 4. Would someone in receipt of a Centrelink payment from April to May receive a top-up payment? Would this be a full payment or pro-rata?

ANSWER:

Carer Payment and/or Carer Allowance do not have a 'top-up' at the end of the financial year. A 'bonus' payment has been made in 2004, 2005 and 2006. This payment is not pro-rata.

- 1. Recipients of the bonus payments must have been receiving Carer Payment and/or Carer Allowance on the relevant budget night.
- 2. Recipients of the bonus payments must have been receiving Carer Payment and/or Carer Allowance on the relevant budget night.
- 3. No.
- 4. If they were in receipt of Carer Payment and/or Carer Allowance on the relevant budget night, they would receive the full bonus payment.

To prepare this answer it has taken approximately 3 hours and 16 minutes at an estimated cost of \$188.
