SENATOR WONG:

RECRUITMENT AGENCY SPENDING

(1) What sum was spent on recruitment agencies in 2006 by each department and agency in the Minister's portfolio?

Answer: 2005–2006 – \$1,830.08 2006–2007 – (YTD) \$12,614.50

(2) Will the Minister provide a list of the recruitment agencies which are used by the department and agencies in the Minister's portfolio?

Answer: Hays Personnel Services (Australia) Pty Ltd, Careers Unlimited Pty Ltd and SOS Recruitment.

(3) What functions do recruitment agencies perform for departments and what would be the likely impact on departmental outcomes from reduction in recruitment spending on external agencies?

Answer: These recruitment agencies will typically be used to supply personnel to fill short-term vacancies that cannot be filled within existing departmental resources or from recruitment registers maintained by the department for this purpose. The likely impact from a reduction in recruitment spending on external agencies would be potential delays in the provision of some services.

(4) What benefit-cost assessments have been done which benchmark internal recruitment processes and/ or on utilising on line recruitment portals?

Answer: Nil
