- 1) The agencies represented on the Humanitarian Resettlement IDC were:

- the Attorney-General's Department; and
- the Department of Finance and Administration.
- 2) DIMA's (now DIAC's) omission from the list provided by PM&C was due to an administrative oversight.
- 3) For the purposes of this IDC, the term 'humanitarian entrant' referred to individuals who are resettled in Australia under the government's Humanitarian Programme.
