Would it be possible to inform the committee, without identifying individuals, of what the largest gap was between the pay level and pay received out of the 21—it will not identify the person, obviously—and what was the lowest gap, so I would have some idea of just how much outside the salary band people were being paid. I ask this for the 21 because I think it is probably anonymous; if you go further down, it would not be.

### Answer:

As at 24 October 2007, there were 21 senior Government staff employed at salaries above the specified salary range for their classification. Attached is a table detailing the positions in which these staff were employed, the normal salary payable to the particular positions, the actual salary paid, and the difference between the two amounts.

The current salary bands for senior staff were approved by the then Prime Minister on 11 May 2006 and are usually reviewed annually to ensure they remain appropriate to the high levels of responsibility and skill expected of senior staff. There was no review in 2007.

It is standard practice not to disclose the remuneration of individual employees under the *Members of Parliament (Staff) Act 1984* whose terms and conditions of employment were covered by AWAs because of privacy considerations,
