Senator Forshaw asked:

Who determines which posts will make voting available? We are talking firstly about people who want to vote in person, but of course also about those who want to apply for or lodge postal votes.

Answer:

The Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) determines which posts will provide voting services, taking into account their operational requirements.

At the 2007 Federal Election, voting was available in 104 overseas locations.

All 86 DFAT posts that provide the full range of consular services, as well as 18 Austrade consulates, provided voting services for the 2007 Federal Election.

A list of the number of votes issued at each overseas voting location is attached.
