- a) Senator Coonan asked: How much is it estimated that each department and agency will spend in 2008-09 on:
 - a. Consultants in total
 - **b.** ITC Consultants
 - c. Legal Consultants
 - d. HR Consultants
 - e. Accounting Consultants
- b) What is the average cost per hour for each department and agency of the above A-E?

Answer:

- a) It is estimated that in 2008-09 the department will spend:
 - a. \$1,336,023 in total on consultants
 - b. nil on ICT consultants
 - c. \$187,167 on Legal consultants
 - d. nil on HR consultants
 - e. nil on Accounting consultants

The estimated expenditure is based on actual expenditure to date plus the known committed costs for contracts already entered into, and estimates of other planned consultancies.

b) The Department is unable to provide the average cost per hour for the above because a large proportion of contracts let for consultancy services are fixed price contracts and, as such, neither the number of hours worked nor an hourly cost is included in the contract.
