**Senator FERGUSON**—If you saved \$120,000 by removing all the pot plants from private areas, how much is it costing you to maintain the pot plants in the public areas?

**Mr Kenny**—We will have to take that on notice and get some calculations done.

## **Answer**

- The purchased pot plants in the public areas will cost approximately \$40 per week (\$2,080 per annum) to maintain.
- The purchased pot plants in the private areas will cost approximately \$70 per week (\$3,640 per annum) to maintain.
- Therefore, the cost to maintain all of the purchased indoor plants in Parliament House is approximately \$110 per week (\$5,720 per annum).
