Senator KROGER—What would be your estimation of the overall cost from that time, including the current budget—

Mr Kenny—The cost of what?

Senator KROGER—of the speed humps, the bollards—the current total of \$1.9 million—what would be the overall cost since 2005 invested in that and the road?

Mr Kenny—I would have to take on notice the bit about the humps.

Answer

- Security works around Parliament Drive between 2005 and 2010 cost \$11.3 million (administered capital funding), of which \$2.26 million is attributed to Bollards.
- 2 Roads works around Parliament Drive between 2005 and 2010 cost \$2.13 million (administered capital funding) comprising:

Consultant reports: \$50,000

Speed humps: \$80,000

Initial one way road conversion: \$100,000

Current works: \$1.9 million

- 3 The current work provided for:
 - Full conversion to a one way road;
 - Resurfacing;
 - Upgrade of the House of Representatives car park to better accommodate motorcycles.
