Senator FIFIELD - Are there any figures which indicate how many DSP recipients have a legal guardian and how many of those DSP recipients who have a legal guardian and who move overseas would lose their pension as a result of staying overseas for more than 13 weeks?

Answer:

Centrelink does not collect information on the number of Disability Support Pension (DSP) recipients with a legal guardian. However, as mentioned at the Senate Estimates hearing on 9 February 2010, Centrelink does have information on DSP recipients with nominees. A nominee is a third party who a DSP recipient can request to have appointed to act on their behalf when conducting business with Centrelink.

There were 133,859 DSP recipients with a nominee as at 29 January 2010.

The number of DSP recipients with a nominee, who had their payment suspended or cancelled as a result of being overseas for more than 13 weeks since July 2008, are outlined in the following table.
