### Question:

- a) How many permanent staff recruited since the supplementary budget estimates?
- b) What level are these staff?
- c) How many temporary positions exist or have been created since budget estimates?
- d) Since supplementary budget estimates, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

#### Answer:

### **Department of Human Services**

- a) The total number of permanent (ongoing) APS staff that has been recruited to fill vacancies created by natural attrition since supplementary budget estimates (20 October 2009) is 136.
- b) The breakdown of permanent (ongoing) APS staff that have been recruited since supplementary budget estimates (20 October 2009) is:

c) The Departmental Human Resource Information System does not record details of 'temporary' positions as such short term or contingent arrangements are classified as 'non-ongoing'. The Department can advise that a total of 49 staff have been engaged on an 'non-ongoing' basis since supplementary budget estimates.

d) Since supplementary budget estimates, 62 contractors have commenced. The average length of employment period for the 62 newly commenced contractors is 196 days or six and a half months.

#### Centrelink

- a) Data from Centrelink's Human Resource Information System (Infolink), shows Centrelink has recruited 316 permanent (ongoing APS) employees in the period 20 October 2009 17 March 2010. The majority of these staff have been recruited to fill existing positions within Centrelink and are not new positions.

- c) Centrelink employs temporary (non-ongoing APS) employees as required to meet demand at the National or Local level.
  - During the period 20 October 2009 17 March 2010 Centrelink's Infolink records show that 312 temporary (non-ongoing APS) employees were engaged.
- d) Centrelink procures contract services through Centrelink's normal procurement practices. Contractors are not included on Centrelink's HR system for payment as payment is made to the company engaged.
  - Centrelink is unable to provide details of average length of employment period for contractors as contracts may be accessed for multiple but differing periods over the term of the contract.

### Medicare Australia

Figures represent headcount.

a) Since supplementary budget estimates (20 October 2009) there have been 45 permanent staff recruited. This includes staff new to the APS or those transferring from other agencies. The majority of these staff have been recruited to fill existing positions within Medicare and are not new positions.

- c) Medicare Australia currently employs 278 temporary employees nationally. Since supplementary budget estimates, 119 temporary employees have commenced.
- d) Since supplementary budget estimates, 203 contractors have commenced at Medicare Australia. The average contract length for these contractors is six months.
