Senator JOYCE The intergovernmental agreement on cost shifting is due for review before 12 February 2011. What arrangements have been put in place for the review process to take place?

Answer:

The Inter-Governmental Agreement Establishing Principles to Guide
Inter-governmental Relations on Local Government Matters (the IGA) was signed by
the Local Government and Planning Ministers Council (LGPMC) in 2006.
Arrangements for the evaluation are currently being considered as part of the
winding-up of the LGPMC work program following the Council of Australian
Governments' decision on 13 February 2011 to reform its system of Ministerial
Councils and to cease operation of the LGPMC.
