Answer

1 There are currently nine first-line support staff and 12 second-line support staff servicing 2020 calls—this is comprised of ongoing full-time and contract staff. These first- and second-line staff are also supported by all other DPS IT staff and vendors.

2 Ongoing IT staffing levels for the past four years are noted below. This does not take into account the 10 contractors who are currently in the IT area. There were two contractors in 2008–09.
