### **Question:**

Senator RYAN: Could you take on notice the number of approvals for travel overseas by cabinet ministers and if there have been any refusals of requests to travel overseas? I appreciate we are straining for time so I am happy for you to take that on notice.

Ms Leon: The question was the number of?

Senator RYAN: The number of times cabinet ministers have been refused permission to travel overseas.

Ms Leon: I can give you the number of trips by financial year that have occurred. It is not broken down by minister.

Senator RYAN: It is probably best to take it on notice as I am particularly interested in the figures by minister. I appreciate that is not information readily available.

#### **Answer:**

The attached table lists the number of visits completed by Cabinet ministers from 14 September 2010 to 13 February 2012.

Ministers are required to seek in-principle approval from the Prime Minister for proposed overseas travel. This process allows the Prime Minister to consider the overall forward program of travel for Ministers, including where there might be overlapping travel proposals. As part of this process during the period January 2011 to 31 March 2012, 11 Cabinet ministers were not given in-principle approval for travel (table also attached), and four Cabinet ministers were given partial in-principle approval.
