### **Question:**

1. How many contractors are currently employed in the department/agency?

- 2. How many contractors have been under contract for a period of more than 2 years?
- 3. How many contractors have been under contract for a period of more than 5 years?
- 4. How many contractors have been under contract for a period of more than 10 years?
- 5. Does the department/agency make a habit of employing contractors to fill positions on a permanent basis?

# **Answer:**

- 1. As at 31 January 2012, the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet has 15 contractors employed.
- 2. Three contractors have been employed under contract for a period of more than two years.
- 3+4. There are no contractors who have been under contract for a period of more than five years.
- 5. The department does not have a habit of employing contractors to fill positions on a permanent basis. Contractors are hired on an ad-hoc basis, for technical expertise that cannot be sourced at the time under the Australian Public Service employment conditions.
