- **1.** How many ongoing staff recruited this financial year to date? What classification are these staff?
- 2. How many non ongoing positions exist or have been created this financial year to date? What classification are these staff?
- **3.** This financial year to date, how many employees have been employed on <u>contract</u> and what is the average length of their employment period?

## Answer:

- 1. The Australian Public Service Commission (APSC) has recruited 50 ongoing employees this financial year to date. The number of staff recruited at each classification were:
  - 3 APS1
  - 3 APS3
  - 5 APS 4
  - 1 APS5
  - 7 APS6
  - 23 EL1
  - 7 EL2
  - 1 SES B1
- 2. The APSC has employed 54 non ongoing employees in 2011-12. 37 of these are still currently employed. The classification of these employees are:
