For the period 1 July 2011 to 31 January 2012 the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (PM&C) spent \$130,687.88 (GST inclusive) on official hospitality; this includes some expenditure on CHOGM related events that were hosted by Ministers. Details are provided at Attachment A. The total figure includes the functions performed by Office of the Arts and Sport (OFTA) and National Portrait Gallery (NPG) for the period 1 July 2011 to 14 December 2011. OFTA and NPG, as of 1 February 2012, have transitioned into the Department of Regional Australia, Local Government, Arts and Sport with the Machinery of Government changes arising from the 14 December 2011 Administrative Arrangements Order.

Events held at NPG are reported at net cost. Either full or partial cost recovery arrangements apply on many NPG events.

In the rare case that entertainment costs are incurred by PM&C the costs are not recorded separately from official hospitality.

The Prime Minister's official hospitality is provided through funding appropriated for State Occasions and Official Visits and Ceremonial Hospitality (CERHOS). For the period 1 July 2011 to 31 January 2012 \$292,553.26 (GST inclusive) was paid through the State Occasions and Official Visits function for the Prime Minister's official hospitality. Details are provided at <u>Attachment B</u>.
