Answer

DPS provided a comprehensive answer in response to this same Question on Notice following the Supplementary Budget Estimates in October 2012 (QoN #150).

Since then, the Security Management Board—which advises the Presiding Officers on security policy and the management of security measures for Parliament House—agreed to adopt the *Australian Government Information Security Manual* as the model for Parliament's ICT security governance arrangements, tailored to the needs of the Parliament. This approach has been approved by the Presiding Officers.
