Ms Mills: ... If it was identified as a site that potentially belongs to a member or a senator or their office, we would have to look at that separately. I have direct control over the management of our own staff but not of others.

Senator RONALDSON: If it was a member or senator, what are the protocols at that stage?

Ms Mills: I doubt that they are clear. I would have to take that on notice.

Answer

The protocol is that DPS would notify the Presiding Officers if a Senator or Member were found to have made inappropriate use of the parliamentary computing account.
