- briefings and documentation for use in the Senate, including the daily Order of Business ('Red'), chamber scripts, *Notice Paper*, *Journals of the Senate*, Dynamic Red, Senate Daily Summary, Bills List, support for whips' meetings, procedural advice:
- legislative drafting services, principally but not exclusively for non-government senators;
- briefings and documentation for use by committees, including schedules of public hearings, individual programs, briefing packs, meeting papers, draft reports, advice to committee chairs and members;
- advice on powers, practices and procedures, either individually tailored in response to senators' requests or for general use, including through such publications as Odgers'
   Australian Senate Practice, the Annotated Standing Orders of the Australian Senate, the Procedural Information Bulletin, Brief Guides to Senate Procedure (and the consolidated Pocket Guide), and Senate Briefs;

- briefings and information on senators' salaries, entitlements administered by the Department of the Senate and services provided by the department in Parliament House;
- information for school programs and on the parliamentary education services provided by the Parliamentary Education Office.

Details are provided in the department's annual reports. As the department's function is to provide services to all senators, statistics are not kept on a party basis.
