## **Question:**

Dr de Brouwer: The officers were here before. They were here for most of this afternoon's discussion. They were called in, I thought, at around 4.30 or 5.00, there were these other meetings.

Senator RYAN: When are they going to get out?

Dr de Brouwer: I thought that they were on their way. I cannot answer that. I am not sure now.

Senator RYAN: Can you take on notice the following. I would like to know: when the notification was sent to the committee; who signed it off; and who sent it. And can I suggest that next time staff are going to be drawn out of here, a schedule known a long time in advance. There is one meeting that happens in this building which is used as a reason for such things and I would hope that it would be something related to that and not an interdepartmental committee or something.
