Answer:

National Mental Health Commission staff do not accompany the Minister or Parliamentary Secretary on their travel.

Commission staff travel cost for this financial year to 11 February 2013 is \$26,807 (ex GST). This includes:

- \$6,676.00 on flights; and
- \$20,131 on accommodation, meals and incidentals.

The Commission does not record travel data in a way that would readily allow answers to be provided to the second part of this question. To attempt to provide this level of detail would involve an unreasonable diversion of resources.

The Commission follows Government travel policy and guidelines in respect of travel for Commission staff.

No lounge memberships have been provided to non-SES staff. The CEO (Agency head) and Deputy CEO (SES Band 2) have lounge memberships.

Support or administrative staff do not travel with SES employees for the purpose of supporting those SES employees. Where secretariat, support and/or administrative staff travel with SES staff it is for legitimate business reasons.
