## Question:

1. How much did each department/agency spend on taxis this financial year to date? Provide a breakdown for each business group in each department/agency.

## Answer:

1. The spend on taxis for the Australian Public Service Commission this financial year to date (31 January 2013) was $\$ 73,742$ exclusive of GST. The table below provides a breakdown of taxi spend by Business Groups for that period.
