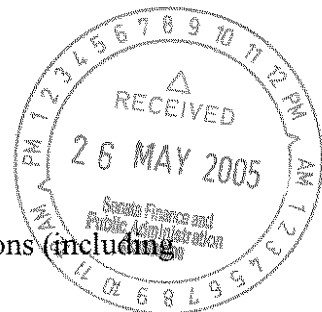


PERSONAL CLASSIFICATIONS
