**SENATOR EVANS** asked the Minister representing the Minister for Human Services, upon notice, on 26 May 2005, to provide a full breakdown of how the \$316 million allocated to the Department of Human Services in the budget for comprehensive work capacity assessments will be spent.

## Answer:

The estimates of expenditure are based on estimated number of customers receiving a comprehensive work capacity assessment (see Q HS14) and on estimates of the average cost of providing such services. The Department of Human Services has commenced development of a sourcing strategy. The Government has indicated that the comprehensive work capacity assessments will be subject to an open tender by no later than 1 July 2008.
