Questions of Notice - Committee Hearings

At the Committee Hearings on 24 May 2005 Senator Faulkner asked a series of questions on notice about Iraqi casualties, and a consultancy agreement ONA has with Dr John Gee. I advise as follows:

2 PM5/

Disaggregation of figures relating to Iraqi ISF casualties

- I undertook to see whether figures I gave the committee on estimates of casualties suffered by the Iraqi Security Forces (ISF) distinguished between police and military casualties. You will recall that the sources of these estimates were the Brookings Institution, the US website Iraq Coalition Casualty Count (ICCC) and Iraqi government ministries.
- Inquiries indicate that estimates by the Brookings Institution and ICCC list total ISF casualties and do not disaggregate military and police personnel.
- As I noted at the hearing, the Iraqi interior and defence ministries have recently started reporting numbers of ISF deaths. These distinguish between military and police personnel. The defence ministry's figures for Iraqi military deaths in April and May were 40 and 85 respectively. The interior ministry's figures for police deaths in the same months were 86 and 151 respectively
