Senator Ray asked:

Could you let me know, on notice, if it can be rectified, what head of power it can be rectified under so that I know where to take it up again at some later time.

Answer:

Providing an entitlement for Life Gold Pass holders to travel by COMCAR, or otherwise use any car-with-driver or hire car services, would require amendment to the *Members of Parliament (Life Gold Pass) Act 2002* (the Act).

Section 4 of the Act currently defines the entitlement as being limited to ... a scheduled commercial transport service or on a combination of scheduled commercial transport services ... [meaning:]

- (a) a scheduled air service; or
- (b) a scheduled rail service; or
- (c) a scheduled bus service; or
- (d) a scheduled tram service; or
- (e) a scheduled ferry service; or
- (f) a scheduled vehicular service.

Section 25 of the Act further provides that a person's entitlement under this Act to a domestic return trip is limited to travel at the expense of the Commonwealth on the scheduled transport service or services concerned.
