The AEC has written to the CFMEU Forestry, Mining and Energy Division in June 2007 seeking a donor return.

The AEC conducted a compliance review of the Australian Labor Party (NSW Branch) in the week starting 4 June 2007, but has not yet completed the review. A response will be provided in relation to the AMWU donation of \$4,000 and CFMEU donation of \$100,000 to the Australian Labor Party (NSW Branch) when the compliance review is complete.
