Senator Faulkner asked: Why did the Prime Minister accept only Senator Santoro's resignation from the ministry?

Answer: The Prime Minister recommended to the Governor-General the acceptance of Senator Santoro's resignation as Minister for Ageing, but, in line with historical precedent, did not recommend that Senator Santoro's membership of the Federal Executive Council be revoked.
