- 2. What is the total cost to date for the Taskforce, separately identifying employee costs, capital/equipment purchased costs and other administrative costs. Please show both new expenses incurred since 31 January 2007 and total cumulative costs.
- 3. Please provide a breakdown of all expenditure items greater than \$10,000 for the categories 'other administration costs' and 'capital equipment purchased', should such costs have been incurred.
- 4. Please provide a breakdown of all expenditures greater than \$10,000 included under 'other administration costs' (expenditure since May 2006) in response to PM 45, part 6 from the October / November 2006 Estimates hearings.
- 5. Please provide a breakdown of all expenditures greater than \$10,000 included under 'capital equipment purchased' (expenditure since January 2007) in response to PM 69, part 4 from the February 2007 Estimates hearings.
- 6. Please provide details of current taskforce staffing levels, broken down by public service grade. For each category, please indicate the number of ongoing and non-ongoing staff.

Answer:

- 1) Total Taskforce travel expenditure from 1 February 2006 to 31 May 2007 is \$2,646,000.
- a) international air travel nil since 1 February 2007.
- b) domestic air travel \$830,000 includes travel for contractors including drivers, host department liaison officers etc. Meetings have been held in Perth, Hobart, Adelaide (two meetings) and Darwin between 1 February 2007 and 31 May 2007.
