Please indicate the total costs of support incurred by Dr Peter Hollingworth since January 1, broken down by:

- a) property operating expenses,
- b) staff,
- c) support, and
- d) travel.

Answer:

Figures for January 2007 were included in the answer to PM 71 from the February 2007 Estimates hearings. The costs incurred during the period 1 February 2007 to 30 April 2007 are as follows:

Item	Cost
Property Operating Expenses	\$ 31,579
Staff	\$ 19,154
Support	\$ 3,806
Travel (including vehicles)	\$ 6,824
Total	\$ 61,363

The expenditure reflects ongoing costs to support the operation of Dr Hollingworth's office. The support provided to Dr Hollingworth, as a former Governor-General, is consistent with that provided to all former Governors-General. The rent on Dr Hollingworth's office is higher than other Melbourne-based former Governors-General, as there is insufficient space in Dr Hollingworth's preferred location in the Commonwealth Parliamentary Offices in 4 Treasury Place.

Please provide details of any expenses over \$5000, paid for with public funds, incurred in facilities provided by the Commonwealth to former Governors-General since 1 July 2006. Please indicate the nature of the expense, the cost and relevant former Governor-General.

Since 1 July 2006, none of the former Governors-General have incurred an individual expense over \$5,000.
