Question: (JOHNSTON)

Can I ask the secretary of the department to come back to me on notice with respect to a full break-up of the \$6,394 with respect to the minister's travel? I think that needs some explanation... I want every leg and what it cost.

Answer:

The Minister travelled from Adelaide to Bali, via Singapore, business class with Singapore Airlines at a cost of \$2,888.27. The return leg from Bali to Adelaide, via Singapore, economy and business class with Qantas Airways, cost \$3,487.25.

The slight decrease in the total for these figures (\$6,375.52) compared to those provided in response to earlier questions reflects updated advice on actual costs from the Department of Finance and Deregulation.
