**Senator Ronaldson asked:**

In a general sense, would you take on notice any capital works or alterations carried out to any Commonwealth parliamentary offices?

**Answer:**

There have been no substantive capital works programs commenced at any of the Commonwealth Parliament Offices (CPO) since the 2007 Federal election. A rolling repair and maintenance program is continuing. Some sound proofing of suites has also been undertaken. The value of individual works at any one of the CPOs has not exceeded \$10,000.
