- From 1 July 2007 to 31 May 2008, total Department travel expenses were \$4,170,111.25. Calculating emissions from government travel is complex and difficult to do in a credible fashion. The Government already reports direct greenhouse gas emissions from selected aviation activities through annual declarations on fuel usage and associated emissions in the energy use in Australian Government Operations report, including the fuel consumed in the operation of the VIP aircraft fleet. Offsets were not purchased.
